

1 [Municipal Utility District Wards]

2 ESTABLISHING WARDS FOR PROPOSED MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT ELECTION.

3 A petition has been circulated, and referred to the Board of Supervisors by the San
4 Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission, for submission to the voters proposing
5 formation of a Municipal Utility District.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, That pursuant to California Public Utilities Code
7 section 11642, wards for the proposed Municipal Utility District are hereby established,
8 bounded and described as follows:

9 FIRST WARD shall comprise all of that portion of the City and County of San Francisco
10 commencing at the point of intersection of the shoreline of the Pacific Ocean and a straight-
11 line extension of Lincoln Way; thence easterly along Lincoln Way to Nineteenth Avenue;
12 thence southerly along Nineteenth Avenue to Judah Street continuing on Parnassus Avenue;
13 thence easterly along a straight-line extension of Parnassus Avenue to the western boundary
14 of the campus of the University of California San Francisco; thence generally northeasterly
15 along the northern boundary of the said campus; thence generally southerly, southeasterly,
16 easterly and northeasterly along the eastern and northeastern boundary of said campus to
17 intersect Stanyan Street; thence southerly in a straight line extension of Stanyan Street to
18 Clarendon Avenue; thence easterly and northeasterly along Clarendon Avenue to Twin
19 Peaks Boulevard; thence northeasterly along Twin Peaks Boulevard to Clayton Street; thence
20 northerly along Clayton Street to Ashbury Street; thence northeasterly and north along
21 Ashbury Street to Frederick Street; thence easterly along Frederick Street to Buena Vista
22 Avenue West; thence southerly along Buena Vista Avenue West and along the southeasterly
23 boundary of Buena Vista Park to Buena Vista Avenue East; continuing on Buena Vista
24 Avenue East easterly and northeasterly along the boundaries of said park to the intersection
25 with Duboce Avenue; thence easterly along Duboce Street to Market Street; thence

1 northeasterly along Market Street to Laguna Street; thence northerly along Laguna Street to
2 California Street; thence westerly along California Street to Presidio Avenue; thence southerly
3 along Presidio Avenue to Geary Boulevard; thence easterly along Geary Boulevard to St.
4 Joseph's Avenue; thence southeasterly and southerly along St. Joseph's Avenue to Turk
5 Boulevard; thence westerly along Turk Boulevard to Masonic Avenue; thence southerly along
6 Masonic Avenue to Fulton Street; thence westerly along Fulton Street to Parker Avenue;
7 thence northerly along Parker Avenue to Lone Mountain Terrace; thence westerly along Lone
8 Mountain Terrace to Stanyan Boulevard; thence northerly along Stanyan Boulevard to Geary
9 Boulevard; thence westerly along Geary Boulevard to Arguello Boulevard; thence northerly
10 along Arguello Boulevard to Lake Street; thence westerly along Lake Street to Twenty-
11 Seventh Avenue; thence southerly along Twenty-Seventh Avenue to California Street; thence
12 westerly along California Street to its point of intersection with the eastern boundary of Lincoln
13 Park; thence northerly along said boundary to the shoreline of the Pacific Ocean; thence
14 westerly and southerly along said shoreline to the point of commencement. Unless specifically
15 designated to the contrary, all references to streets, boulevards, drives, avenues, terraces and
16 ways contained in the foregoing description shall refer to the centerlines of said streets,
17 boulevards, drives, avenues, terraces and ways, respectively.

18 SECOND WARD, shall comprise all of that portion of the City and County of San
19 Francisco commencing at the point of intersection of the shoreline of the Pacific Ocean and
20 the eastern boundary of Lincoln Park; thence southerly along said boundary to California
21 Street; thence easterly along California Street to Twenty-Seventh Avenue; thence northerly
22 along Twenty-Seventh Avenue to Lake Street; thence easterly along Lake Street to Arguello
23 Boulevard; thence southerly along Arguello Boulevard to Geary Boulevard; thence easterly
24 along Geary Boulevard to Stanyan Boulevard; thence southerly along Stanyan Boulevard to
25 Lone Mountain Terrace; thence easterly along Lone Mountain Terrace to Parker Avenue;

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1 thence southerly along Parker Avenue to Fulton Street; thence easterly along Fulton Street to
2 Masonic Avenue; thence northerly along Masonic Avenue to Turk Boulevard; thence easterly
3 along Turk Boulevard to St. Joseph's Avenue; thence northerly and northwesterly along St.
4 Joseph's Avenue to Geary Boulevard; thence westerly along Geary Boulevard to Presidio
5 Avenue; thence northerly along Presidio Avenue to California Street; thence easterly along
6 California Street to Laguna Street; thence southerly along Laguna Street to Eddy Street;
7 thence easterly along Eddy Street to Gough Street; thence northerly along Gough Street to
8 Ellis Street; thence easterly along Ellis Street to Larkin Street; thence northerly along Larkin
9 Street to Post Street; thence easterly along Post Street to Mason Street; thence southerly
10 along Mason Street to Ellis Street; thence easterly along Ellis Street to Powell; thence
11 southerly along Powell Street to Market Street; thence Northeasterly along Market Street and
12 a straight-line extension of Market Street to the Embarcadero; thence southerly along the
13 Embarcadero to the point of intersection with the straight-line extension of Mission Street
14 northeasterly to the shoreline of San Francisco Bay and including all piers north of said
15 intersection; thence generally northerly and westerly to the eastern boundaries of the Presidio;
16 continuing along the northerly boundaries of the Presidio along said shoreline westerly and
17 northerly to the Pacific Ocean shoreline; continuing southerly along said shoreline including
18 the Presidio boundary on the west to the point of commencement. The Second Ward shall
19 include Yerba Buena and Treasure Islands. Unless specifically designated to the contrary, all
20 references to streets, boulevards, drives, avenues, terraces and ways contained in the
21 foregoing description shall refer to the centerlines of said streets, boulevards, drives, avenues,
22 terraces and ways, respectively.

23 THIRD WARD, shall comprise all of that portion of the City and County of San
24 Francisco commencing at the intersection of the southern boundary of the city and county and
25 the centerline of Junipero Serra Boulevard; thence northerly along Junipero Serra Boulevard

1 to Brotherhood Way; thence southeasterly and south along Brotherhood Way to Alemany
2 Boulevard; thence southeasterly along Alemany Boulevard to the intersection of the Southern
3 Freeway (Interstate Route 280); thence easterly and northeasterly along the centerline of the
4 Southern Freeway (Interstate Route 280) to Bosworth Street; thence northwesterly along
5 Bosworth Street to O'Shaughnessy Boulevard; thence generally northwesterly along
6 O'Shaughnessy Boulevard to Portola Drive; thence northeasterly along Portola Drive to Twin
7 Peaks Boulevard; thence generally northerly along Twin Peaks Boulevard to Clarendon
8 Avenue; thence westerly along Clarendon Avenue and a straight-line extension thereof to
9 Stanyan Street; thence northerly along Stanyan Street to the intersection of Stanyan Street
10 and Seventeenth Street; thence westerly to the intersection of a straight-line extension of
11 Seventeenth Street with the eastern boundary of the campus of the University of California
12 San Francisco; thence northerly, northwesterly and westerly along the eastern and
13 northeastern boundary of said campus to Parnassus Avenue; thence westerly along
14 Parnassus Avenue continuing on Judah Street to Nineteenth Avenue; thence northerly along
15 Nineteenth Avenue to Lincoln Way; thence westerly along Lincoln Way and a straight-line
16 extension of Lincoln Way to the point of intersection with the shoreline of the Pacific Ocean;
17 thence southerly along said shoreline to the southern boundary of the city and county; thence
18 easterly along said boundary to the point of commencement. Unless specifically designated to
19 the contrary, all references to streets, boulevards, drives, avenues, terraces and ways
20 contained in the foregoing description shall refer to the centerlines of said streets, boulevards,
21 drives, avenues, terraces and ways, respectively.

22 FOURTH WARD, shall comprise all of that portion of the City and County of San
23 Francisco commencing at the intersection of San Jose Avenue and Bosworth Street; thence
24 northwesterly along Bosworth Street to O'Shaughnessy Boulevard; thence generally
25 northwesterly along O'Shaughnessy Boulevard to Portola Drive; thence northeasterly along

1 Portola Drive to Twin Peaks Boulevard; thence generally northerly along Twin Peaks
2 Boulevard to Clarendon Avenue; thence easterly along Clarendon Avenue to Twin Peaks
3 Boulevard; thence northeasterly along Twin Peaks Boulevard to Clayton Street; thence
4 northerly along Clayton Street to Ashbury Street; thence northeasterly and northerly along
5 Ashbury Street to Frederick Street; thence easterly along Frederick Street to Buena Vista
6 Avenue West; thence southerly along Buena Vista Avenue West to Buena Vista Avenue East;
7 thence northeasterly along Buena Vista Avenue East to Duboce Avenue; thence easterly
8 along Duboce Avenue to Market Street; thence northeasterly along Market Street to Guerrero
9 Street; thence southerly along Guerrero Street to Seventeenth Street; thence easterly along
10 Seventeenth Street to the centerline of the James Lick Freeway (State Route 101); thence
11 generally southerly along the centerline of the James Lick Freeway (State Route 101) to the
12 interchange with the Southern Freeway (Interstate Route 280); thence generally
13 southwesterly along the centerline of the Southern Freeway (Interstate Route 280) to the
14 intersection with a northerly straight-line extension of Bowdoin Street; thence southerly along
15 that straight-line extension and Bowdoin Street to Sweeney Street; thence westerly along
16 Sweeny Street to Colby Street; thence southerly along Colby Street to Silver Avenue; thence
17 westerly along Silver Avenue to Amherst Street; thence southerly along Amherst Street to
18 Felton Avenue; thence westerly along Felton Street to Cambridge Street; thence southerly
19 along Cambridge Street to Wayland Street; thence westerly along Wayland Street to Oxford
20 Street; thence northerly along Oxford Street to Bacon Street; thence westerly along Bacon
21 Street to Harvard Street; thence northerly along Harvard Street to Burrows Street; thence
22 westerly along Burrows Street to Mansfield Street; thence northwesterly on Mansfield Street
23 to LaGrand Avenue; thence north and northwesterly along LaGrand Avenue to Avalon
24 Avenue; thence southwesterly to the centerpoint of the intersection with Moscow Street;
25 thence northwesterly along Avalon Avenue to Mission Street; thence southwesterly along

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1 Mission Street to Ocean Avenue; thence westerly along Ocean Avenue to the intersection of
2 the centerline of the Southern Freeway (Interstate Route 280); thence northeasterly and
3 easterly along the centerline of the Southern Freeway (Interstate Route 280) to San Jose
4 Avenue; thence northeasterly along San Jose Avenue to the point of commencement. Unless
5 specifically designated to the contrary, all references to streets, boulevards, drives, avenues,
6 terraces and ways contained in the foregoing description shall refer to the centerlines of said
7 streets, boulevards, drives, avenues, terraces and ways, respectively.

8 FIFTH WARD, shall comprise all of that portion of the City and County of San
9 Francisco and the City of Brisbane commencing at the point of intersection of a northeasterly
10 straight-line extension of Mission Street and the shoreline of San Francisco Bay; thence
11 southwesterly along said straight-line extension of Mission Street to the Embarcadero; thence
12 northwesterly along the Embarcadero to the intersection with a northeasterly straight-line
13 extension of Market Street; thence southwesterly along Market Street to Powell Street; thence
14 northerly along Powell Street to Ellis Street; thence westerly along Ellis Street to Mason
15 Street; thence northerly along Mason Street to Post Street; thence westerly along Post Street
16 to Larkin Street; thence southerly along Larkin Street to Ellis; thence westerly along Ellis
17 Street to Gough Street; thence southerly on Gough Street to Eddy Street; thence westerly
18 along Eddy Street to Laguna Street; thence southerly along Laguna Street to Market Street;
19 thence northeasterly along Market Street to Guerrero Street; thence southerly along Guerrero
20 Street to Seventeenth Street; thence easterly along Seventeenth Street to the centerline of
21 the James Lick Freeway (State Route 101); thence generally southerly along the centerline of
22 the James Lick Freeway (State Route 101) to the interchange with the Southern Freeway
23 (Interstate Route 280); thence generally southeasterly along the centerline of the Southern
24 Freeway (Interstate Route 280) to the intersection with a northerly straight-line extension of
25 Bowdoin Street; thence southerly along that straight-line extension and Bowdoin Street to

1 Sweeney Street; thence westerly along Sweeny Street to Colby Street; thence southerly along
2 Colby Street to Silver Avenue; thence westerly along Silver Avenue to Amherst Street; thence
3 southerly along Amherst Street to Felton Avenue; thence westerly along Felton Street to
4 Cambridge Street; thence southerly along Cambridge Street to Wayland Street; thence
5 westerly along Wayland Street to Oxford Street; thence northerly along Oxford Street to
6 Bacon Street; thence westerly along Bacon Street to Harvard Street; thence northerly along
7 Harvard Street to Burrows Street; thence westerly along Burrows Street to Mansfield Street;
8 thence northwesterly on Mansfield Street its end; thence northerly to LaGrand Avenue; thence
9 north and northwesterly along LaGrand Avenue to Avalon Avenue; thence southwesterly to
10 the centerpoint of the intersection with Moscow Street; thence northwesterly along Avalon
11 Avenue to Mission Street; thence southwesterly along Mission Street to Ocean Avenue;
12 thence westerly along Ocean Avenue to the intersection of the centerline of the Southern
13 Freeway (Interstate Route 280); thence southerly and southwesterly along the centerline of
14 the Southern Freeway (Interstate Route 280) to the intersection with Alemany Boulevard;
15 thence northwesterly along Alemany Boulevard to Brotherhood Way; thence northwesterly
16 and westerly along Brotherhood Way to Junipero Serra (Interstate Highway 1); thence
17 southerly from the center point of intersection along Junipero Serra (Interstate Highway 1) to
18 the southern boundary of the City and County of San Francisco; thence easterly to Bayshore
19 Boulevard; thence southwesterly across the boundary of the County of San Mateo along the
20 easterly boundaries of the City of Brisbane, encompassing and including the entire
21 boundaries of the City of Brisbane including southerly, westerly and southwesterly to the
22 shoreline of San Francisco Bay; thence northerly along the San Francisco Bay shoreline,
23 including all piers and rows of vessels to the boundary of San Mateo; thence across the
24 boundary of the City and County of San Francisco following the shoreline generally
25 northeasterly including all piers and rows of vessels to the point of commencement. Unless

1 specifically designated to the contrary, all references to streets, boulevards, drives, avenues,
2 terraces and ways contained in the foregoing description shall refer to the centerlines of said
3 streets, boulevards, drives, avenues, terraces and ways, respectively.

4 Voters residing within the boundaries of the City and County of San Francisco as
5 established in Government Code Section 23138 or within the boundaries of the City of
6 Brisbane, but not on the San Francisco Peninsula, Yerba Buena Island, or Treasure Island,
7 shall be deemed for the purpose of the municipal utility district election to reside in the ward
8 on the Peninsula closest to the voter's place of residence.


