WHEREAS, On September 3, 2003, the Immigrant Rights Movement, through Carlos Petroni, filed an appeal of the Department's decision to the Board of Supervisors, under the provisions of Section 801 of the San Francisco Traffic Code; and,

WHEREAS, The appellants sought to reverse the decision of the Director and have the permit issued, and also sought to achieve a reduction in the fees that would be charged by the City for the conduct of the event; and,

WHEREAS, Section 801 of the Traffic Code requires that the appeal be scheduled for the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Supervisors, in conformance with public notice requirements, and that meeting is September 16, 2003; and,

WHEREAS, On September 16, 2003, the Board of Supervisors conducted the hearing on the appeal and considered all of the public testimony presented by all interested persons, both oral and written; now, therefore, be it

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
