AMENDING ARTICLE 3 OF PART III OF THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL CODE, BY AMENDING SECTION 257, ELIMINATING THE PENALTY ON TRANSIENT MERCHANTS THAT VIOLATE THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 3 DURING THE SUSPENSION PERIOD.

Section 1. Article 3 of Part III of the San Francisco Municipal Code is hereby amended by amending Section 257, to read as follows:

SEC. 257. PENALTY. (a) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b) below, ((A)) <u>any person violating any of the provisions of this Article shall be deemed guilty of a</u> misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

(b) During the suspension period, as defined in paragraph (c) of Section 258 of this Article, paragraph (a) above shall not apply to transient merchants.
