MARY'S RECREATION CENTER, ST. MARY'S SQUARE, UNITED NATIONS PLAZA, WASHINGTON SQUARE PARK, AND WEST SUNSET PLAYGROUND TO THE LOCATIONS IN WHICH ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IS PROHIBITED WITHOUT A PERMIT.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Article 4 of the San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by amending Section 4.10, to read as follows:

- (a) No person shall consume alcoholic beverages of any kind in any building, children's playground, swimming pool, restroom, or any of the parks or portions of parks as follows, except with the permission of the Recreation and Park Department.
