Section 1. Making Environmental Findings. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.030626 and is incorporated herein by reference.

Program, which provides recreational and tutorial programs, and a nutritious snack, after school and
during the summer at certain neighborhood recreation centers:

The Recreation and Park Commission shall adopt polices and procedures to offer reduced rates to low-income families.

Section 7. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.31, to read as follows:

SEC. 12.31. Field Trip Reimbursement. From time to time, field trips and outings are offered as part of the Department's recreation programs. The Department shall collect a reimbursement fee from participants to cover all, or a portion of, the costs of transportation, food, admission charges and other associated expenses. If the full reimbursement required is \$10.00 per person, or less, the Department shall charge the full amount. If the reimbursement required is more than \$10.00 per person, the Department shall charge \$10.00, and an additional amount to cover at least 50% of expenses over \$10.00 person. The Recreation and Park Commission shall adopt polices and procedures to offer reduced rates to low-income families.

Section 8. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.32, to read as follows:

SEC. 12.32. Resident Golf Cards. An annual fee of \$40.00 shall be charged for San Francisco Resident Golf Cards, entitling the holder to discounts on the golf courses under the jurisdiction of the Recreation and Park Department shall be available to San Francisco residents only.
