Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter dated December 12, 2002, which stated that this project is in conformity with the San Francisco General Plan. A copy of such letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. ___030541______.

Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works' Order No. 173,907, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 030541, Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Section 1559. A portion of official sidewalk on the westerly side of Lyon Street south of Bay

Street shall be abolished as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-553, a copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 030541.

Section 3. The Presidio Trust, as is necessary as a result of this Ordinance, shall make arrangements with public utility companies and City departments for the relocation and/or adjustment of existing utility facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas. Any necessary relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County of San Francisco.
