The Department of Parking and Traffic shall replace all existing parking and traffic control signs defaced by graffiti with new signs treated with graffiti-resistant sheeting. All new parking and traffic control signs installed by the Department of Parking and Traffic shall be treated with graffiti-resistant sheeting.
