Board amendment deletions are strikethrough normal. Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco: Section 1. Article 17.2 of the San Francisco Police Code is hereby amended by adding Section 1320.2, to read as follows: SEC. 1320.2 PROHIBITION AGAINST SELLING WITHIN 1500 FEET OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL. No operator of a mobile catering vehicle shall offer for sale or give away any food or drink for human consumption within 1500 feet of the property line of any public middle school, junior high school, or high school- between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., unless the Chief of Police has approved such sales in accordance with Section 1320.17 of this Article, and the sales are made from a construction site, and the mobile catering vehicle is parked entirely on private property, and the operator does not sell or give away food or drink to minors. Section 2. Within 30 days of the effective date of this ordinance, the Chief of Police shall do the following: (1) Notify all persons who hold permits for the operation of mobile catering vehicles of the provisions of this ordinance.

Supervisor Elsbernd , MIVBavimi BOARD OF SUPERVISORS (2) Review the approved route and stops for all permit holders to determine whether any of approved stops violate the terms of this ordinance.

(3) If a permit holder's approved route includes a stop that is within 1500 feet of the property line of any public middle school, junior high school, or high school, notify the permit holder that such stop is no longer approved.

(4) Submit a report to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors stating whether any existing, approved routes or stops violate the terms of this ordinance, and attach to that report a copy of the notice provided to all permittees under subsection (1), above, and any notices provided to permittees under subsection (3), above.
