In the event the injunction is lifted or stayed, -*Ithis ordinance shall expire* 20 one year from date of said action. June 30, 2008. If, however, If, during that year, the Commission, 21 after conducting public hearings, finds that the purposes identified in Section Chapter 12D.A.3 22 have not vet been achieved and the program continues to be required under federal law, the 23 Commission shall certify that finding to this Board no later than 120 days prior to the 24 expiration date. Thereafter, upon finding a good cause, this Board may extend the ordinance 25 for additional three-year periods.
