- (c) Pursuant to Planning Code Section 302, this Board finds that this Ordinance will promote the public necessity, convenience, safety and welfare for the reasons set forth in Commission Resolution No. 18569 , which is incorporated herein by reference.
- (d) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120188 and is incorporated herein by reference.
- (e) On March 21, 2012, the Building Inspection Commission conducted a public hearing on this legislation.

Section 2. This Section is uncodified.

- (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the Planning Code, including the fee schedule associated with Sections 355(a) and 355(e), the permit fee for awning replacement and for signs, respectively, are hereby waived for any permit issued for such activities during the month of May 2012.
- (b) Notwithstanding any provision of the Building Code, including the fee schedules of Tables 1A-A and 1A-E, the permit fees related to reviewing the structural integrity of awning replacements for those permits submitted "over the counter" at the Central Permit Bureau and installation of pedestrian level lighting, respectively, are hereby waived for any permit issued for such activities during the month of May 2012.

Section 3. The fee waivers set forth in this Ordinance shall apply only to small business enterprises. The Board of Supervisors hereby delegates to the Department of Building Inspection and the Planning Department the establishment of a process by which the respective departments will certify that an applicant is a small business enterprise.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the date of passage; provided, however, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be retroactive to May 1, 2012 should the effective date of the Ordinance occur after said date.

Section 4. This section is uncodified. In enacting this Ordinance, the Board intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent part of the Planning Code that are explicitly shown in this legislation as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the legislation.
