AMENDING PART II, CHAPTER XI, OF THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL CODE

(TRAFFIC CODE) BY ADDING SECTION 131 TO ARTICLE 7 OF THE CODE,

ADOPTING A PENALTY SCHEDULE FOR THE LATE PAYMENT OF PARKING TICKETS

AND PROVIDING THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MAY BY RESOLUTION DECLARE

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Article 7 of the San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding Section 131, to read as follows:

SEC. 131. LATE PAYMENT PENALTIES. (a) The penalty for failure to pay a parking penalty or contest the underlying citation by the first due date affixed to the notice of parking violation shall be \$12. The penalty for failure to pay a parking penalty or contest the underlying citation by the second due date affixed to the notice of parking violation shall be \$15. (b) By resolution, the Board of
