Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

IAuthorizing the Director of Public Works to use San Francisco Zoo Staff to perform

Section 1. FINDINGS. The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby finds and declares as follows:

- In 1997, the voters of San Francisco approved Proposition C, the Zoo Facilities Bonds, authorizing the City to incur \$48 million of bonded indebtedness for the acquisition. construction and/or reconstruction of San Francisco Zoo facilities ("Zoo Bond Funds").
- B. The San Francisco Zoo, Department of Public Works ("DPW"), and Recreation & Parks Department ("Rec Park") have requested a supplemental appropriation of \$16,898,894 from the Zoo Bond Funds as initial funding for projects under the San Francisco Zoo Phase II Master Plan ("Zoo Master Plan").
- C. The Zoo Master Plan allocates \$913,500 of this supplemental request for construction work, including but not limited to, painting, structural repairs, paving, utilities, and security systems, related to repair and replacement of San Francisco Zoo facilities ("Repair and Replacement Work").
- D. Some of the Repair and Replacement Work will take place in connection with zoo exhibits which will be in operation at the time work is performed. Some of the Repair and Replacement Work will be performed on small exhibits that are part of larger exhibits, and

would not otherwise be performed for another 15 years when the larger exhibits are to be replaced. To minimize the disruption and adverse effects on zoo animals, the San Francisco Zoo, DPW, and Rec Park agree that San Francisco Zoological Society staff, who are experienced in working with operating animal exhibits, are uniquely qualified to perform this Repair and Replacement Work.

E. The Director of Public Works has determined that contracting directly with San Francisco Zoological Society for zoo staff to perform some or all of the Repair and Replacement Work is in the best interest of the City.

## Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby

- A. Waives the competitive bidding and public contracting requirements of the Administrative Code Sections 6.05-6.07, 6.09, and 6.1 for the purposes stated herein; and
- B. Authorizes the San Francisco Zoo, Department of Public Works, and Recreation & Parks Department to expend Zoo Bond Funds for the Repair and Replacement Work described herein and in the accompanying supplemental funding request; and
- C. Authorizes the Director of the Public Works ("Director") pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 2A.190, to contract with the San Francisco Zoological Society, without advertising for competitive bids, said contract not to exceed \$913,500.
