WHEREAS, Authors of ballot arguments may be penalized financially for inadvertent errors even if the ballot argument form is submitted in a timely fashion; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Department of Elections to review and update its local ballot argument form and fee schedule; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board requests the Department of Elections to report back to the Board within ninety days regarding this matter.
