2 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, PUBLIC HEALTH  
3 DIVISION, COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES TO ENTER INTO AN EXPANDED  
4 COOPERATIVE PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF  
5 REHABILITATION SAN FRANCISCO DISTRICT, INCLUDING A REQUIRED MATCH  
6 OF \$181,355, AND WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE PATENT INFRINGEMENT  
7 INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES, TO PROVIDE VOCATIONAL  
8 SERVICES TO MENTALLY-ILL PSYCHIATRIC CLIENTS.

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10 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health Division, Community Mental Health  
11 Services, is the Designated Cooperative Agency in the provision of State funding for vocational  
12 services to mentally ill psychiatric clients in San Francisco; and,

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13 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health, Public Health Division, Community  
14 Mental Health Services, annually enters into a Cooperative Program Agreement with the  
15 Department of Rehabilitation San Francisco District; and,

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16 WHEREAS, The State Department of Rehabilitation requires an annual Board of  
17 Supervisor's Resolution designating approval of the Cooperative Program Agreement (the  
18 "Agreement") copies of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.  
992205; and,

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20 WHEREAS, The Agreement includes a required local cash match in the amount of  
21 \$181,355 from the San Francisco Community Mental Health General Fund; and,

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22 WHEREAS, The Agreement authorizes direct funding from the Department of  
23 Rehabilitation San Francisco District to two Case Service Contracts in the total amount of  
24 \$556,453 for the delivery of vocational rehabilitation services to clients of the Department of  
25 Public Health, Community Mental Health Services; and

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WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors desires to authorize the Department of Public Health to enter in to the Agreement; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health, Public Health Division, Community Mental Health Services, is hereby authorized to <sup>expand an existing</sup> ~~enter into a~~ Cooperative Program Agreement with the Department of Rehabilitation San Francisco District to provide vocational services to mentally ill psychiatric clients; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an indemnification of the City by the Department of Rehabilitation San Francisco District for the infringement of patent rights; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Section 6.57 (c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57 (a) of the Administrative Code.


