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APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AN EXISTING CONTRACT WITH BOOZ-ALLEN & HAMILTON, INC. (CS-103) FOR CONSULTANT ENGINEERING SERVICES TO COMPLETE THE LIGHT RAIL FLEET REPLACMENT PROCUREMENT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION UNDER THE CONTRACT BY AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,800,000.

WHEREAS, The Municipal Railway fleet contains 77 Breda light rail vehicles that have replaced Boeing light rail vehicles that were beyond their useful life; and

WHEREAS, Muni has a contract with Breda Costruzioni Ferroviarie, S.p.A. ("Breda") for an additional 59 light rail vehicles to complete the fleet replacement of the 136 Boeing fleet by August, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Muni has a contract with Alcatel Transport Automation to provide on-board signal equipment to interface with the Breda cars; and

WHEREAS, Muni awarded contract CS-103 to Booz-Allen & Hamilton, Inc. (the "Agreement"), for the completion of the light rail fleet replacement after a competitive national process complying with Federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, Proposed Supplemental Amendment No. 2 to CS-103 will complete the 77-car LRV2 procurement, complete the 59-car procurement, and provide support for the on-board signal equipment for an amount not to exceed \$7,800,000; and

WHEREAS, A copy of the original Agreement, Amendment No. 1, Amendment No. 2 and Proposed Supplemental Amendment No. 2 to CS-103 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 992308; and

WHEREAS, Sixty-nine percent of the funds for this Amendment will be provided by Federal, twelve percent by State, and nineteen percent by local sources available in the light rail vehicle fleet replacement funding program; and

WHEREAS, On April 6, 1999, pursuant to Resolution No. 99-033, a copy of which is on

file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 992308, the Public Transportation Commission approved the scope of work under Amendment No. 2 and Supplemental Amendment No. 2 to Contract CS-103 to extend the engineering support services to complete the procurement contracts for 136 light rail vehicles and ATCS on-board equipment by September 2001; and

WHEREAS, This scope of work was divided and approved as a single amendment but which is to be performed under separate amendments. The first portion covered the delivery of the first two of the fifty-nine light rail vehicles and the associated engineering costs and was executed in September 1999. The Supplemental Amendment No. 2 covers procurement support for the balance of the 59 vehicles; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board hereby approves Supplemental Amendment No. 2 to Contract No. CS-103 with Booz-Allen & Hamilton, Inc., for consultant engineering services to complete the light rail fleet replacement program for an amount not to exceed \$7,800,000, increasing the total contract amount to an amount not to exceed \$15,722,354; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Board hereby authorizes the City's Purchaser and Director of Administrative Services to execute the Amendment on behalf of the City.
