5 WHEREAS, The Hearst Corporation has offered the San Francisco Examiner for sale
6 along with certain assets of the San Francisco Newspaper agency; and

7 WHEREAS, The majority of employees of the San Francisco Examiner and the
8 Newspaper Agency are represented by unions, and work under negotiated contracts that
9 cover such areas as salary, benefits, schedules, workplace conditions, seniority and job
10 security; and

11 WHEREAS, Union leaders representing more that 2,300 employees at the San
12 Francisco Examiner and the San Francisco Newspaper Agency insist that any new buyer
13 honor the existing union contracts; now, therefore be it; the public entity is acting as market
14 participant; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
16 hereby supports the sale of the San Francisco Examiner to a buyer who is committed to
17 honoring existing labor agreements with its unionized staff.
