URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUILDING INSPECTION TO CREATE A SYSTEM FOR TRACKING ROOM AVAILABILITY AND OCCUPANCY IN ALL OF SAN FRANCISCO'S RESIDENTIAL HOTELS.

WHEREAS, The 1990 Hotel Conversion Ordinance is limited in its ability to provide an accurate picture of the availability and occupancy in San Francisco's residential hotels; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is not able to gauge whether the SRO housing stock can meet its short-term housing needs; and,

WHEREAS, Increasingly the City is relying on residential hotels as a housing resource for its marginalized populations that do not have access to a stable housing source; and,

WHEREAS, The City seeks to link supportive services to housing in order to provide substance abuse and mental health treatment and other transitional social services for those formerly homeless; and,

WHEREAS, Fires, demolitions, conversions, and earthquake damage have substantially decreased the number of residential hotel rooms available to lower-income San Franciscans; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco suffers from a less than a one percent vacancy in the housing rental market, thus adequate knowledge of available SROs could assist in providing housing for those who need it; and,

WHEREAS, It is essential that the City know its housing stock availability in order to direct its resources properly; now, be it therefore,

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Building Inspection to create a database that regularly reports activity on all San Francisco

SRO hotels, especially occupancy rates, tenant make-up, and the physical condition of hotels occupied by homeless people.
