APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO REPLACE THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE SEWER ON 4th STREET BETWEEN BRYANT STREET AND BRANNAN STREET.

WHEREAS, On February 15, 2000, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency sewer condition on 4th Street between Bryant Street and Brannan Street; and

WHEREAS, The existing 3' x 5' brick sewer located on 4th Street between Bryant Street and Brannan Street had collapsed, resulting in ground settlement, sand infiltration, and multiple hidden voids throughout the entire block; and

WHEREAS, Immediate repairs and sewer replacement were required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property of the Public; and

WHEREAS, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Clean Water Program Contract No. CW-274E, "4th Street Emergency Sewer Replacement," to replace the existing sewer with approximately 600 feet of 42-inch diameter Hobas fiberglass pipe sewer and 42 feet of 12-inch diameter no-dig vitrified clay pipe sewer; and

WHEREAS, The cost of the project is projected to be \$542,540.00, of which \$447,890.00 is for the construction contract; and

WHEREAS, Funds are available from the 1995B Sewer Bond under Job Order No. 0140J (Fund 5C/CPF/95B, FAMIS Project No. CEN95BSI01); and

WHEREAS, The Contractor, D'Arcy & Harty Construction, Inc., began the emergency work on March 2, 2000 and all work should be completed by March 28, 2000; and

WHEREAS, Because this is an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals are not required; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Department's Major Environmental Analysis Section has determined the Clean Water Program's sewer replacement program to be categorically exempt from environmental

review under the State Guidelines implementing the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.60 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an emergency; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on 4th Street between Bryant Street and Brannan Street.
