URGING GOVERNOR GRAY DAVIS TO FUND THE EXTENSION OF CALTRAIN TO DOWNTOWN SAN FRANCISCO IN HIS PROPOSED BUDGET FOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, Proposition H called for the City of San Francisco to electrify Caltrain and extend it to the Transbay Terminal downtown; and,

WHEREAS, In November of 1999, San Francisco voters overwhelmingly approved Proposition H; and,

WHEREAS, The extension of Caltrain to downtown is an effective way of improving transit service and reducing traffic congestion in San Francisco, provides more new transit riders per dollar than any other state rail project, has long been a regional priority, and would serve to upgrade the Transbay Terminal to modern seismic standards; and,

WHEREAS. Despite these factors, the City has yet to take definitive steps to implement the initiative and has not urged Governor Davis to include funding for the Caltrain extension; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges Governor Gray Davis to fund the extension of Caltrain to Downtown San Francisco in his proposed budget for transportation projects; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Resolution is not intended to displace or diminish projects already earmarked for San Francisco in the Governor's proposed budget; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the California Department of Transportation and the Honorable Gray Davis, Governor of the State of California.
