WHEREAS, The Controller determined on April 28, 2000, that said services can be performed at lower cost by a private contractor to the Department of Human Services than by employees of the City and County; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller's determination and approves that the Department of Human Services may contract for security services.
