WHEREAS, Proposition K, passed by the voters in 1979, created a new class of permit holders, notably imposing a driving requirement on permit holders in exchange for the privilege of holding a

City-owned medallion; and,

[Medallion Waiting List Information]

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Commission developed a method of doling out permits, based on names submitted to the waiting list; and,

WHEREAS, In furtherance of the intent of Proposition K, the San Francisco Police Code allows preference in the waiting list to be given to persons who have been driving for at least one year; and,

WHEREAS, Presently, no method exists for informing drivers of the need to put their name on this waiting list as a prerequisite to be considered for holding a medallion as these medallions become available; and,

WHEREAS, Drivers must register on an annual basis with the Tax Collector's Office in order to receive their A-card, a permit to drive a taxi; and,

WHEREAS, The Tax Collector's Office previously conducted a successful survey of drivers by disseminating surveys during A-card renewals; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco does hereby urge the San Francisco
Tax Collector's Office, working with the Police Department's Taxi Detail and the City Attorney's
Office, to inform working taxi drivers about the steps required to obtain a taxi medallion by making this
information available to drivers during their annual A-card renewal every year; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco asks that copies of this legislation be sent to the San Francisco Taxi Commission; the Tax Collector's Office; the Taxi Detail; and the City Attorney's Office.
