1 PROCLAIMING, ON THE OCCASION OF THE SILVER ANNIVERSARY OF THE
2 FOUNDING OF GAY AMERICAN INDIANS, JUNE 23, 2000 AS "GAY AMERICAN INDIANS
3 DAY" IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO.

5 WHEREAS, Gay American Indians (GAI) was founded in July of 1975 and is the oldest
6 organization in the United States and Canada of Two Spirit People, or Native-Americans who
7 are gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender; and,

8 WHEREAS, GAI has been the cradle board for the many new organizations, both
9 locally and nationally, supporting and serving the Native-American gay, lesbian, bisexual and
10 transgender community; and

11 WHEREAS, GAI's publication of the groundbreaking book "Living The Spirit", which is
12 an anthology: of writings by and about gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender peoples of
13 Native descent, has been a source of inspiration, affirmation and pride for Two
14 Spirit People"; and

15 WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of GAI organized the American Indian AIDS
16 Institute (AIAI) which is the first Native American HIV/AIDS education and prevention
17 program in San Francisco designed to also served the cultural and spiritual needs of the
18 Native-American community in the Bay Area; and

19 WHEREAS, Other similar local and national Native-American HIV/AIDS organizations
20 have modeled their programs after AIAI; and

21 WHEREAS, GAI truly and firmly believes that empowerment begins with the restoration
22 of the cultural, historical and spiritual legacy of the Two Spirit People; and

23 WHEREAS, GAI firmly supports the basic concept of the dignity of human rights for all
24 peoples and mutual respect for all people based; now therefore be it
