WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible according to MTC rules and regulations; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Director of Public Works to accept and expend \$100,000 in state STP Exchange funds for the Southwest Gateway Improvement Project and to execute any and all documents necessary therefore.
