AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$1,000,000 IN FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION EQUITY ACT FOR THE 21ST CENTURY (TEA21) FUNDS GRANTED THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR THE BROADWAY CORRIDOR TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT WITH REQUIRED LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS OF \$129,561.

WHEREAS, The United State Congress enacted the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA21)in June 1998, which made approximately \$14.4 billion available in federal funds to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans); and

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) has created the Transportation for Livable Communities (TLC) capital grant program to provide funding for bicycle-, pedestrian-, and transit-oriented developments that are eligible under the criteria set forth in MTC Resolution 3212; and

WHEREAS, the MTC has recommended the programming of \$1,000,000 in federal funds through its TLC program for capital improvements for the Broadway Corridor Transportation Improvements Project; and,

WHEREAS, The federal funding will cover 88.5 percent of eligible costs, as defined by the Federal Highway Administration and administered by the California Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible, according to Federal Highway Administration rules and regulations; and,
