WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; and, \$42,000

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$12,200; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement contained in Section 21.21 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement includes an indemnification of the City by HUD for the infringement of patent rights, copyright, trademark, and other intellectual property rights; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement that the Agreement includes a paragraph reciting the false claims provisions contained in Section 21.35 of the Administrative Code; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Health to enter into similar agreements with HUD if the grant recurs or is renewed; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Controller should be urged to designate the position created under the grant as a "G" or grant-funded position, which would terminate when the grant expires.
