WHEREAS, Section 10.104.15 of the San Francisco Charter allows Departments to contract for services when it has been determined by the Controller and approved by a resolution of the Board of Supervisors to be economical; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency is required by the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 to provide paratransit services for persons with disabilities who are unable to use fixed-route public transit; and

WHEREAS, The Office of Controller has determined that contracting for paratransit services with outside firms at fixed unit cost rates is more economical than providing the same services with City employees; now, therefore be it retroactively,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with the Controller's determination that paratransit services for the Municipal Railway can be practically performed by a private contractor at a lower cost than by City and County employees for the period of Fiscal Year 2000-01.
