AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND THE AMOUNT OF \$ 62,100 FROM THE STATE BOARD OF CORRECTIONS PURSUANT TO THE MENTALLY ILL OFFENDER CRIME REDUCTION GRANTS PROGRAM (MIOCR); AND, APPROVING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MIOCR STRATEGY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, Due to the deinstitutionalization of severely mentally ill individuals that occurred in the 1970, many mentally ill people now remain untreated, resulting in impaired functioning, poverty, homelessness and self-medication with alcohol and controlled substances; and,

WHEREAS, These behaviors often necessitate police intervention resulting in incarceration; and,

WHEREAS, The State Board of Corrections has made available funding, through Mentally Ill Offender Crime Reduction grants, for development of programs designed to address the needs of mentally ill offenders during incarceration and upon release; and,

WHEREAS, The State requires that the Board of Supervisors authorize the Sheriff to apply for, accept and expend such funding, including indirect costs, assisted by a Strategy Committee consisting of mental health professionals and representatives from affected City and criminal justice agencies; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco authorizes Sheriff Michael Hennessey to apply for, accept and expend \$ 62,100 of MIOCR funding for the purpose of

updating a comprehensive plan to address the treatment of mentally ill offenders while in custody and after release; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors appoints Sheriff

Michael Hennessey Chair of the San Francisco Mentally Ill Offender

Crime Reduction Strategy Committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the appointment of the following individuals as members of the San Francisco Mentally Ill Offender Crime Reduction Strategy Committee: Ron Albers, Deputy Public Defender; Linda Allen, Assistant District Attorney; Armando Cervantes, Chief Adult Probation Officer; Officer Mike Cowhig, San Francisco Police Department; David Fariello, LCSW, Director, Citywide Case Management; Barbara Garcia, Director, Population, Health and Prevention; Barbara Havassy, Director, UCSF Treatment Outcome Research Group; Travis Kiyota, Mayor's Criminal Justice Council; Michael Lund, Citywide Case Management; Jean Mariani, Budget and Program Manager, San Francisco Sheriff's Department; Jo Robinson, MFCC, Director, Jail Psychiatric Services; Jo Ruffin, LCSW, Director, Community Mental Health Services;

FURTHER RESOLVED, That Sheriff Michael Hennessey is authorized to sign the City and County of San Francisco's application for State funding as well as related contracts, amendments or extensions with the State of California; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will adhere to the requirements of the Board of Corrections and all

conditions specified in the grant contract with the State of California in the expenditure of State funds pursuant to this grant; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That all final planning products will be developed and provided to the Board of Corrections no later than March 1, 2001; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will invoice the Board of Corrections for all costs approved in the grant no later than June 30, 2001.
