URGING THE CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNOR DAVIS TO
APPROVE SENATE BILL 65 TO ESTABLISH AND ALLOCATE \$20 MILLION TO THE

WHEREAS, Current law requires local transportation planning agencies and commissions to adopt plans to consolidate social service transportation services; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 65 appropriates \$20 million from the General Fund to create the Welfare-to-Work Account in the Transportation Fund; and,

WHEREAS, Transit providers could use the funds to provide CalWORKS recipients with transportation to jobs, school, or child care facilities, to purchase vehicles, or to design transportation management systems; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 65 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 65 is supported by the California Transit Association, the Amalgamated Transit Union, the United Transportation Union, County Welfare Directors Association of California, the Contra Costa Transportation Authority, the County of San Diego, the San Mateo County Transit District, the Ventura County Transportation Commission, the Rail Passenger Association of California, Santa Clara County, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, the Placer County Transportation Planning Authority, and the San Francisco County Transportation Authority; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco endorses Senate Bill 65 and urges the Legislature and Governor to approve this legislation; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the State Legislature, as well as Governor Davis, with a request they take all action necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
