URGING THE PORT COMMISSION TO DECLARE THEIR INTENTION OFFICIALLY TO
MAINTAIN THE FISHING INDUSTRY ON THE WATERFRONT, PARTICULARLY IN THE
FISHERMAN'S WHARF AREA AND TO ESTABLISH A CAPITALIZATION PLAN TO DEVELOP

WHEREAS, The commercial fishing industry has been a vital force along San Francisco's waterfront since the 1860's, commencing with the Filbert Street, Green Street, Union Street, and Vallejo Street piers; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco's waterfront fishing industry is the location of the largest wholesale fish operation on the West Coast; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco's waterfront is one of the nation's largest seafood distribution centers, receiving fish by boat, rail, trucks and air; and

WHEREAS, The Burton Act calls for the maintenance, reconstruction, promotion and protection of fisheries along the waterfront; and

WHEREAS, The 1997 Port Commission Resolution No. 97-83, contained in the Port of San Francisco Waterfront Land Use Plan, adopted guidelines for long term uses of waterfront space for the fishing industry, including fish processing and wholesaling; and

WHEREAS, The Port of San Francisco Waterfront Land Use Plan calls for the protection and infrastructure enhancement of current maritime activities including incentives for maritime industries to invest in facility

improvements and to seek alternative funding sources to ensure such protection; and

WHEREAS, State Senate President John Burton has announced intentions to obtain \$2 million in state funding to develop new businesses at Shed C of Pier 45 and to help restore "Fish Alley"; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco, in maintaining the long term viability of its waterfront fishing industry, urges the Port Commission to declare their intention officially to maintain the fishing industry and establish a capitalization plan in San Francisco's Fisherman's Wharf.
