[Design Build Contract]

APPROVING THE DESIGN-BUILD AGREEMENT FOR THE SOUTHEAST COGENERATION FACILITY CONTRACT, CS-520, NOT TO EXCEED \$3,181,743.

WHEREAS, The SFPUC's Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant (SEWPCP) generates one million standard cubic feet per day of digester gas, a renewable resource resulting from the decomposition of organic waste material; and,

WHEREAS, The digester gas is currently being flared; and,

WHEREAS, The process of producing electricity and steam from digester gas reduces odors from the SEWPCP; and,

WHEREAS, The SFPUC approved the advertisement of a Request for Proposal for a developer to finance, design, build and operate a cogeneration plant at the SEWPCP on November 10, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, The SFPUC has requested proposals from qualified developers to recover the energy from the digester gas and generate electricity and heat; and,

WHEREAS, The SFPUC through its Resolution 99-0250 on September 28, 1999 authorized SFPUC staff to negotiate a contract with Sierra Diesel Detroit Allison (SDDA); and,

WHEREAS, The SFPUC has negotiated a contract with SDDA, a qualified developer; and,

WHEREAS, The State of California's California Energy Commission (CEC) has awarded a subsidy of \$0.139 per kilowatt-hour for all electricity produced by this project during its first five years of operation, an estimated one million and one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) to the SFPUC for an energy recovery project at the SEWPCP; and,

WHEREAS, In order to earn the full amount of the CEC subsidy, this energy recovery project must be operational by January 1, 2002; and,

WHEREAS, The subcontracting goals are 20% combined MBE/WBE for design services and 30% combined MBE/WBE for construction services, and the proposed developer has agreed to meet these goals; and,

WHEREAS, Funds are available in Project #CUH943; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby award a design-build contract, not to

exceed \$3,181,743, to SDDA to design and build a cogeneration plant at the SEWPCP.
