Resolution urging San Francisco money wire transfer services to eliminate fees for

sending funds to El Salvador for the next 90 days to recognize the country's state

of emergency.

WHEREAS, There is a state of emergency in El Salvador due to the 7.6-magnitude earthquake which hit the country on Saturday, January 13; and

WHEREAS, The earthquake severely damaged or destroyed at least 100,000 homes and killed an estimated 687 people; and

WHEREAS, The earthquake and its aftershocks left an estimated \$1 billion in damage – nearly half the yearly budge in the nation; and

WHEREAS, Over 150,000 Salvadorans live in the Bay Area and over 50,000 reside in San Francisco and, as the second-largest Latino group after those of Mexican descent, they are vital to the functioning of the Bay Area economy; and

WHEREAS, A delegation representing the Bay Area Salvadoran community (led by a member of the Board of Supervisors) traveled to El Salvador on Saturday, January 20 to hand deliver \$250,000 to organizations working in the worst-affected rural communities; and

WHEREAS, According to U.S. governmental studies and the consul general for San Francisco's Salvadoran consulate, last year Bay Area Salvadorans sent a record amount of at least \$2.4 billion home to their families; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Salvadorans have endured the terrible loss of family members and loved ones; and

WHEREAS, United States money wire transfer services, such as Western Union, MoneyGram, and banks charge money transfer fees, most starting at \$12 per transaction, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby urge all money wire transfer services to waive their transfer fees for sending money to El Salvador for the next 90 days; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors is directed to notify all money wire transfer services of this request, including Western Union, MoneyGram, and banks.
