8 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has applied for and been
9 awarded a two year grant from the EPA in the amount of \$98,399 for a program to
10 reduce indoor environmental triggers for asthma; and,

11 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the EPA requires the
12 City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the
13 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 002215, which is hereby declared
14 to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$8,208;
17 now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to
20 accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code
21 section 10.170-1; and, be it




FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller should be urged to designate the position created under the grant as a "G" or grant-funded position, which would terminate when the grant expires.
