l'Extension of Exclusive Negotiations between the Port of San Francisco and the Malrite Company.]

Resolution opposing the decision by the Port of San Francisco to extend Exclusive Negotiations with the Malrite Company regarding Pier 45 for an additional ninety (90) days until April 15, 2001.

WHEREAS, The Port Commission issued a Request for Proposals for lease of Pier 45 which solicited development proposals for a public attraction that is "compatible with the fishing industry" and includes a "significant maritime component" among other criteria; and

WHEREAS, this Request for Proposals had two bidders: the Malrite Company's San Francisco at the Wharf, an entertainment complex; and the Bay Conservation Center, an educational center focused on Bay conservation and ecology; and

WHEREAS, Approval was granted by the Port Commission to the Malrite Corporation to enter into a Term of Exclusive Right to Negotiate with the Port of San Francisco for a four month period from August 15, 2000 to December 15, 2000 during which time the parties were to negotiate an agreement regarding the terms for Malrite's development regarding the development of San Francisco at the Wharf at Pier 45; and,

WHEREAS, Public opposition to the Malrite Company's proposal and support for the Bay Center concept materialized in the passage of Proposition R in November 2000 by over 72% of San Francisco voters, which made it City policy to use Pier 45 as public educational facility, run by a non-profit group, that focuses on the San Francsico Bay: and

WHEREAS, despite demonstrated opposition to the Malrite Company's proposal and support for the Bay Center concept, the Port's Executive Director has authorized the

extension of the Original Term of the Exclusive Right to Negotiate agreement for an additional ninety (90) days until April 15, 2001; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors opposes the decision by the Port of San Francisco and the Port Commission to extend exclusive negotiations with the Malrite Company an additional ninety days and strongly urges the Port to cease negotiations with Malrite Company on April 15, 2001, the date to which currently contracted Exclusive Negotiations extend.
