

1 [Parking Regulations to Modify Previously Approved Residential Permit Parking Regulations  
2 for a portion of the Potrero Hill Neighborhood]

3 **Resolution Rescinding and Enacting Various Residential Permit Parking Regulations in**  
4 **the Potrero Hill Area.**

5  
6 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 588-00 establishing  
7 Residential Permit Parking Area "X" in the Potrero Hill Area with the condition that the  
8 Department of Parking and Traffic present a parking report to the Transportation and Land  
9 Use Committee on September 26, 2000; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic made this presentation on  
11 September 26, 2000; and,

12 WHEREAS, The parking studies performed by the Department of Parking and Traffic  
13 showed that Pacific Bell Ballpark was having virtually no effect on neighborhood parking  
14 conditions; and,

15 WHEREAS, The primary sources of non-resident parking in the neighborhood are  
16 related to the presence of the Caltrain 22<sup>nd</sup> Street Station and the various businesses in the  
17 area; and,

18 WHEREAS, More businesses are expected to move into the neighborhood, thereby  
19 further limiting the availability of on-street parking for residents; and,

20 WHEREAS, The parking regulations approved by Resolution No. 588-00 were written  
21 to primarily address the potential parking impacts of Pacific Bell Ballpark in the neighborhood;  
22 and,

23 WHEREAS, It would be reasonable to modify those previously approved regulations to  
24 more accurately address the parking problems in the neighborhood; and,

1           WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic was asked at the Board's  
2           September 26, 2000, Transportation and Land Use Committee meeting to address the  
3           parking concerns of businesses in the area by excluding their frontages from the permit  
4           parking regulations; now, therefore, be it

5           RESOLVED, That in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and  
6           the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the parking of vehicles  
7           are hereby rescinded or enacted as designated below:

9           RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "X" (2-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT, 8 AM – 10  
10          PM, EVERYDAY) – RESCIND

11           Connecticut Street, both sides, between 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Streets (400 block)

12           Mississippi Street, both sides, between 20<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> Streets (500 and 600 blocks)

13           Pennsylvania Street, both sides, between 19<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> Streets (500, and 600 blocks)

14           Texas Street, both sides, between 20<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> Streets (500 and 600 blocks)

15          RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "X" (3-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT, 11 AM – 5  
16          PM, EVERYDAY; 2-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT, 5 PM – 9 PM, EVERYDAY) – RESCIND

17           18<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between Pennsylvania and Texas Streets (1100 and 1200  
18           blocks)

19           19<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between Pennsylvania and Texas Streets (1100 and 1200  
20           blocks)

21           19<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, from Pennsylvania Street to east terminus (1000 block)

22           Connecticut Street, both sides, between 17<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Streets (100, 200, and 300  
23           blocks)

24           Mariposa Street, both sides, between Mississippi and Arkansas Streets (1100, 1200,  
25           1300, and 1400 blocks)

1 Mississippi Street, both sides, between 19<sup>th</sup> and Mariposa Streets (200 and 300 blocks)

2 Missouri Street, both sides, between 17<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Streets (100, 200, and 300 blocks)

3 Pennsylvania Street, both sides, between 19<sup>th</sup> and Mariposa Streets (200 and 300  
4 blocks)

5 Texas Street, both sides, between 17<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Streets (100, 200, and 300 blocks)

6 RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "X" (2-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT, 8 AM – 6 PM,  
7 MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY) – ESTABLISH

8 Connecticut Street, west side, between 17<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Streets (100, 200, 300, and 400  
9 blocks)

10 Connecticut Street, east side, from 127 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 20<sup>th</sup> Street (100  
11 block, starting with address #121, plus the 200, 300, and 400 blocks)

12 Missouri Street, west side, from 166 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street (100 block,  
13 starting with address #140, plus the 200 and 300 blocks)

14 Missouri Street, east side, from 178 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street (100 block,  
15 starting with address #145, plus the 200 and 300 blocks)

16 Mississippi Street, west side, from 127 feet south of Mariposa Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street (200  
17 block, starting with address #226, plus the 300 block)

18 Mississippi Street, east side, from 152 feet south of Mariposa Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street (200  
19 block, starting with address #225, plus the 300 block)

20 Mississippi Street, west side, from 20<sup>th</sup> Street to 228 feet north of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street (500 and  
21 600 blocks, up to and including #642)

22 Mississippi Street, east side, from 20<sup>th</sup> Street to 177 feet north of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street (500 and  
23 600 blocks, up to and including #661)

24 Pennsylvania Street, west side, from 253 feet north of Mariposa Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street  
25 (200 block, starting with address #210, plus the 300 block)

- 1 Pennsylvania Street, east side, from 208 feet south of 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street (300
- 2 block, starting with address #355)

- 9 Texas Street, east side, from 228 feet south of 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 19<sup>th</sup> Street (100 block,
- 10 starting with #165, plus the 200 and 300 blocks)
- 11 Texas Street, west side, from 20<sup>th</sup> Street to Sierra Street (500 and 600 blocks)
- 12 Texas Street, east side, from 20<sup>th</sup> Street to Sierra Street (500 and 600 blocks, up to
- 13 and including address #613)
- 14 18<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between Pennsylvania and Texas Streets (1100 and 1200
- 15 blocks)
- 16 19<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between Pennsylvania and Texas Streets (1100 and 1200
- 17 blocks)
- 18 19<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, from Pennsylvania Street to east terminus (1000 block)
- 19 Mariposa Street, north side, between Mississippi and Arkansas Streets (1100, 1200,




