3 **Resolution urging the Department of Public Works to delay construction related to the**
4 **opening of Davis Street until March 26, 2001, during which time the City Attorney is**
5 **requested to determine whether the deletion of this project from Embarcadero**
6 **Roadway Project will sacrifice State and Federal funding to the City and County of San**
7 **Francisco.**

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10 WHEREAS, the opening of Davis Street between Washington and Clay Streets is a
11 planned phased of the Embarcadero Roadway Project; and

12 WHEREAS, this opening of Davis Street would replace a pedestrian pathway through
13 open space on the Western end of what is currently known as Ferry Park; and,

14 WHEREAS, there is a possibility that the City and County of San Francisco will
15 jeopardize Federal and State funding to the Embarcadero Roadway Project—totaling in the
16 tens of millions of dollars, if this construction project is not implemented; and,

17 WHEREAS, the reopening of Davis Street is an approved project that is scheduled to
18 begin in earnest on the week of March 19, 2001; now, therefore, be it
~~being~~

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
20 urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to delay the commencement of this construction
21 project two weeks, until March 26, 2001; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That during this period of delay, the City Attorney will be
23 asked to determine whether deletion of the opening of Davis Street from the Embarcadero
24 Roadway Project will jeopardize Federal and State funding provided to the Embarcadero
25 Roadway Project; and, be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the City Attorney determines that the deletion of this
2 project will not cause the removal of this funding from State and Federal entities, that the
3 Department of Public Works is instructed to explore and pursue alternate options that will
4 allow traffic flow commensurate to the reopening of Davis Street.




