FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Municipal Transportation Agency, as the new tenant in the Department of Aging and Adult Services former space, shall reimburse the Department for the value of improvements made to this space; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Landlord shall transfer to the City approximately 88 Office work stations currently existing at the premises, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The City shall pay its pro-rata share of operating cost increases based upon a 2001 calendar base year for the additional area.
