Jamie Rossi, new appointment, Seat 4, must be a representative of a business association, for a new term ending June 30, 2001;

Stanley Warren (residency requirement waived), new appointment, Seat 5, must be a representative of organized labor, for a new term ending June 30, 2001;

Tom Radulovich, new appointment, Seat 6, must be a representative of an urban planning association, for a new term ending June 30, 2001;

Carlos Romero (residency requirement waived), new appointment, Seat 7, must be a representative of an affordable housing organization, for a new term ending June 30, 2001;

Robert Haaland, new appointment, Seat 8, must be a representative of a tenant organization, for a new term ending June 30, 2001;

Debra Walker, new appointment, Seat 9, must be a representative who is an artist or represents an arts organization, for a new term ending June 30, 2001;

Michael Strausz, new appointment, Seat 10, must be a representative who is a residential builder, for a new term ending June 30, 2001; and, be FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Live/Work Task Force has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicants Stanley Warren and Carlos Romero, new appointees, who are not residents of San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the Live/Work Task Force.
- 3.
