[HIV Treatment in Prisons Lawsuit] Resolution urging the City Attorney to join the statewide injunction filed in U.S. District Court, San Francisco, by nine plaintiffs represented by Donald Specter of the Prison Law Office against the California State Corrections Department regarding insufficient treatment of prisoners with HIV.

WHEREAS, Prisoners-rights advocates have accused the California State Corrections Department of systematically ignoring the medical needs of California's 160,000 prisoners, particularly ignoring the needs of HIV positive prisoners; and,

WHEREAS, Nine inmates and their lawyer Donald Specter of the Prison Law Office have filed a class action suit against the Corrections Department charging that the department's health care system suffers from poor training, staff shortages, delays in access to doctors and testing, interference by guards and insufficient care for HIV-positive prisoners; and,

WHEREAS, Obstructing prisoners from receiving care for life threatening diseases like HIV would constitute cruel and unusual punishment and the City of San Francisco opposes this kind of treatment of individuals who deserve the same basic rights as all citizens; and,

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has a great interest in identifying ways of stopping the spread of HIV; and,

Mark Leno BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, Proliferation of HIV within correctional facilities is unconscionable when correctional facilities are <u>controlled environments and one of the few areas where</u> government can play a strong role in slowing the spread of HIV; and,

WHEREAS, Given the alleged civil rights abuses in this case, as well as the need to slow the spread of HIV, the City of San Francisco has a great interest in joining the above mentioned lawsuit; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the City Attorney to join the statewide injunction filed in U.S. District Court, San Francisco, by nine plaintiffs represented by Donald Specter of the Prison Law Office against the California State Corrections Department regarding insufficient treatment of prisoners with HIV.
