[Establish a research study of medical marijuana.]

Resolution urging the San Francisco Department of Public Health to establish a research study of medical marijuana and to establish formal procedures for the cannabis buyers clubs of San Francisco to apply to become participants in the research study.

WHEREAS, The Supreme Court held on May 14, 2001 that medical necessity is not a defense to manufacturing and distributing marijuana under the Controlled Substances Act in <u>United States v. Oakland Cannabis Buyers Cooperative</u>; and

WHEREAS, In that decision, the Supreme Court recognized an exemption to the Controlled Substances Act's prohibition on the manufacture and distribution of marijuana for government-approved research projects; and,

WHEREAS, The Controlled Substances Act provides procedures to submit registration applications for government-approved research projects, 21 U.S.C. section 823(f); and

WHEREAS, Medical researchers have generally agreed that there is a dearth of research on the human health effects of medical marijuana; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City of San Francisco urges the San Francisco Department of Public Health to establish a research study of medical marijuana that would comply with the requirements of section 823(f) of the Controlled Substances Act; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City of San Francisco also urges the San Francisco Department of Public Health to establish formal procedures for the cannabis buyers clubs of San Francisco to apply for registration within the Department of Public Health's research study.
