Resolution urging the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency to take such action as will accomplish the equal application of City and County development policy to all areas of the City and County including new and existing Redevelopment Project Areas.

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency is currently considering three new project areas in the Mid-Market, Transbay and Bayview Hunters Point; and,

WHEREAS, these new areas, if approved, will be added to the existing project areas already undergoing urban renewal; and,

WHEREAS, the majority of these existing and proposed project areas are in or adjacent to other areas of San Francisco undergoing intense study and review for new planning policies by the department of City Planning; and,

WHEREAS, in addition to these new studies the Planning Department and the Board of Supervisors routinely amends the Planning Code and other local codes which affect commercial and residential land uses specifically including, but not limited to, expanded mitigation fees for transit, affordable housing, resident employment and childcare, and in some cases these amendments are not applied in a timely manner to proposed development in Redevelopment Agency Project Areas; and,

WHEREAS, it is the case that in some instances land use and mitigation policies in Redevelopment Project Areas differ substantially from other similar areas subject only to local codes; and,

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City and County of San Francisco to have a single development policy binding on all departments and commissions of the City and County of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Board of Supervisors requests that the Executive Director and Commission of the Redevelopment Agency to take such action as will accomplish the equal application of City and County development policy, specifically including, but not limited to, policies involving mitigation payments for transit and affordable housing, to all areas of the City and County including new and existing Redevelopment Project Areas to the fullest extent of the law, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors requests that the Executive Director and the Commission report to the Board of Supervisors no later than 120 days after the effective date of this resolution on the actions they have taken to meet this request, including, if necessary, the need for any new legislation required to effect this policy.
