6 WHEREAS, Marion Aird has lived in San Francisco for over 25 years and has been a
7 resident of the Outer Mission for over 23 years; and,

8 WHEREAS, Marion Aird has served as member of the New Mission Terrace
9 Improvement Association, Financial Secretary of Communities of the Outer Mission
10 Organization (COMO), Board President of Neighbors of the Excelsior (NOTE), President and
11 Vice-President of the San Francisco League of Neighborhoods, Financial Secretary and
12 Board Member of the Excelsior Youth Club, Vice President of the Coalition for San Francisco
13 Neighborhoods, Co-founder, Board Member, and Newsletter Editor for the Outer Mission
14 Residents Association (OMRA), and a member of the Committee to Restore the Geneva
15 Office Building and Powerhouse; and,

16 WHEREAS, Over the past 20 years Marion Aird has devoted intelligence,
17 determination, and insight to the tackling of numerous issues pertaining to zoning and
18 planning, public transportation, the Balboa Park BART station, services for youth, and
19 improved access to health service for residents in the Outer Mission; and,

20 WHEREAS, As a member of COMO Marion Aird worked to acquire an emergency
21 station of St. Luke’s Hospital on Alemany and Onodaga Street and as a member of NOTE
22 Marion Aird co-authored a Neighborhood Design Guideline and served on the Task Force
23 Member to create Residential Conservation Amendments for the Excelsior District; and,
