6 WHEREAS, the Salvation Army is an international relief organization founded by
7 William Booth in 1865; and,

8 WHEREAS, since September 11, 2001, the Salvation Army has been at the site of the
9 World Trade Center, the crash site of United Airlines Flight #93, and the Pentagon; and,

10 WHEREAS, As a result of their work, relief workers and victims have been served
11 891,000 meals; and,

12 WHEREAS, In Pennsylvania, the Salvation Army is still serving 1500 to 1800 meals a
13 day for relief workers at the crash site; and,

14 WHEREAS, at the Pentagon, "Camp Unity" has been organized in conjunction with the
15 Department of Defense to provide kitchens, food, and logistical supply tents for the relief
16 workers; and,

17 WHEREAS, the Salvation Army has organized two emotional and spiritual relief
18 centers near the site of the World Trade Center for the workers; and,

19 WHEREAS, the Salvation Army is storing nearly a million square feet of donated
20 goods in 24 warehouses in the Greater New York area; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
22 commends the Salvation Army for their good works on behalf of the relief workers in New
23 York, Pennsylvania, and Washington, DC.
