## RESOLUTION NO. 922-0

Resolution authorizing the Airport Commission to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for acquisition of clean air vehicles and infrastructure, and related technical assistance<u>: placing</u> <u>\$100,000 on reserve</u>.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to its Clean Vehicle Policy, the Airport seeks to reduce vehicle emissions in the region and near the Airport; and,

WHEREAS, Clean air vehicle and infrastructure acquisition, and related technical assistance, are eligible for Federal funding under the Federal Aviation Administration's Inherently Low Emission Airport Vehicle (ILEAV) Pilot Program; and,

WHEREAS, SFO was selected for ILEAV funding in a competitive process involving many airports; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project would assist in funding 136 natural gas and electric autos and utility vehicles for City staff, 4 City-contracted natural gas Airport Shuttle buses, 176 airline-operated electric baggage tractors and belt loaders, 11 electric fast chargers for airline vehicles, and related technical assistance; and

WHEREAS, THE Airport Commission, in Resolution 01-0301, approved seeking, accepting, and expending the subject funds; and

WHEREAS, THE Airport would administer this grant, disburse incentive funds to third party operators, and provide the Federal Government with information concerning the new vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Airport proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in this grant budget; now, therefore, be it
