3 **Resolution commending the Airport Commission and the Regional Director of the**
4 **Immigration and Naturalization Service for sponsoring citizenship workshops to enable**
5 **airport security screeners to maintain employment in their current positions once the**
6 **Federal Aviation Security Bill is implemented.**

8 WHEREAS, The Federal Aviation Security Bill requires that all airport security
9 screeners be U.S. citizens; and

10 WHEREAS, Approximately eighty percent of all airport security screeners at San
11 Francisco International Airport are foreign nationals; and,

12 WHEREAS, Eighty percent of the airport security screeners at San Francisco
13 International Airport will not be able to keep their jobs when the Aviation Security Bill is
14 implemented; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation will not likely implement the
16 federalization of airport security screeners until the end of 2002; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Airport Commission along with the Immigration and Naturalization
18 Service will be sponsoring a number of citizenship workshops to facilitate the application
19 process for any airport security screener wishing to become an American citizen in order to
20 maintain employment in their current positions; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
22 commend the Airport Commission and the Regional Director of the Immigration and
23 Naturalization Service for sponsoring citizenship workshops in order to allow airport security

1 screeners to maintain working in their current positions once the new Federal Aviation
2 Security bill is implemented; and, be it
