3 Resolution urging Treasure Island Development Authority (TIDA)  
4 to include specific sustainable development standards and  
5 requirements in its Request for Proposals (RFP) to develop  
6 Treasure Island and Yerba Buena Island.

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco developed a  
9 Request for Qualifications for the development of Treasure  
10 Island and Yerba Buena Island; and,

11 WHEREAS, Only one respondent, Treasure Island Community  
12 Development, was deemed eligible to move to the RFP stage; and,

13 WHEREAS, The RFP stage is a critical time for the community  
14 to offer input and direction into the redevelopment of the  
15 Islands; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors in 1996 adopted "The  
17 Sustainability Plan for the City and County of San Francisco;"  
18 and,

19 WHEREAS, Elements of sustainable development should be  
20 incorporated into the RFP; and,

21 WHEREAS, Increased traffic congestion on the Bay Bridge,  
22 the enjoyment of being on the islands, and sustainability goals  
23 all demonstrate a need to make the Islands as car-free as  
24 possible; and,

1           WHEREAS, Another element of the RFP should be a specific  
2           commitment to clean ferry service, powered by renewable energy,  
3           to existing ferry terminals; and,

4           WHEREAS, The RFP should include the construction of a  
5           wetlands system for water treatment, wildlife habitat,  
6           environmental education, and visitor enjoyment; and,

7           WHEREAS, The RFP should also require adherence to the best  
8           management practices of the City's Resource Efficient Buildings  
9           Program; and,

10          WHEREAS, Another element of the RFP should require the  
11          preservation of a generous amount of open space to serve the  
12          needs of the Islands' residents and visitors; and,

13          WHEREAS, The RFP should respect the spirit and letter of  
14          the Public Trust Doctrine; now, therefore be it

15          RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and  
16          County of San Francisco hereby urges the Treasure Island  
17          Development Authority (TIDA) to include specific sustainable  
18          development standards and requirements in its Request for  
19          Proposals (RFP) to develop Treasure Island and Yerba Buena  
20          Island.
