7 WHEREAS, Lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) young  
8 people in American society face tremendous discrimination, violence  
9 and harassment in their everyday lives; and,

10 WHEREAS, LGBT youth are much more likely to drop out of school  
11 or commit suicide than their straight counterparts; and,

12 WHEREAS, In an attempt to educate people about the challenges  
13 facing LGBT youth, a documentary titled "Out in the Cold" was  
14 produced depicting the harsh realities of the lives of runaway LGBT  
15 youth who have fled their families and homes to escape persecution  
16 and find a more accepting and nurturing environment and,

17 WHEREAS, The documentary was produced and directed by Martin  
18 Bedogne and Eric Criswell in conjunction with the CIRE Foundation,  
19 Gay & Lesbian Adolescent Social Services (GLASS) and the Matthew  
20 Shepard Foundation; and,

21 WHEREAS, In an effort to bring this important message to San  
22 Francisco, a special viewing of "Out in the Cold" will take place on  
23 Saturday, March 23, 2002 at the Metropolitan Community Church; and,

1           WHEREAS, The film will be followed by a panel discussion with  
2 members of the community including Judy Shepard, the producers and  
3 directors of the film and some of its youth; and,

4           WHEREAS, The documentary promises to enlighten and educate  
5 thousands of people about one of the most important social issues of  
6 our time and help create a more civil and less violent society; now,  
7 therefore be it

8           RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of  
9 Supervisors hereby commends the directors, producers and sponsors of  
10 "Out in the Cold," a documentary film about runaway gay, lesbian,


