

1 [FEDERAL FUNDING - EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANTS PROGRAM]
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3 **Resolution approving the 2002 Emergency Shelter Grants Program and**
4 **Expenditure Schedule; and authorizing the Mayor on behalf of the City and**
5 **County of San Francisco to accept, and expend a \$879,000 entitlement under the**
6 **Emergency Shelter Grants Program from the U. S. Department of Housing and**
7 **Urban Development.**

9 WHEREAS, Under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and
10 Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the Secretary of the U.S.
11 Department of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make a grant to San
12 Francisco under the Emergency Shelter Grants Program. The grant may be used for the
13 rehabilitation or conversion of buildings for use as emergency shelters for the homeless,
14 for the payment of certain operating and social services expenses in connection with
15 emergency shelters, and for homeless prevention; and

16 WHEREAS, The Mayor will be able to use the grant monies to improve the
17 operation of existing emergency shelters and thereby enhance the very basic living
18 standards of homeless persons in the City; and;

19 WHEREAS, The grant monies will be devoted to provision of essential services for
20 the shelters, payments for operating the shelters, and homeless prevention; and

21 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Community Development has prepared an
22 Expenditure Schedule designating the use of the \$879,000 Entitlement; and

23 WHEREAS, A Preliminary Environmental Record has been prepared on the
24 proposed activities; and

1 WHEREAS, it has been determined that no environmental evaluation is required to
2 accept and expend the City's 2002 Emergency Shelter Grants Program (ESGP)
3 entitlement; and

4 WHEREAS, the Certifying Officer shall follow procedural provisions of NEPA to
5 make certain that all projects are in compliance with the applicable federal provisions and
6 requirements; and


7 WHEREAS, indirect costs have been allocated in the 2002 Community
8 Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program to cover both CDBG and ESGP; now,
9 therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, that the Mayor's Office of Community Development is hereby
11 authorized to apply for, accept, and expend a grant of \$879,000 from the U.S. Department
12 of Housing and Urban Development under the Emergency Shelter Grants Program; and,
13 be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the
15 Expenditure Schedule for recipient agencies; and, be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit
17 documentation and certifications required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban
18 Development.
