8 WHEREAS, San Francisco public school children deserve adequate facilities to
9 receive an exceptional education; and,

10 WHEREAS, San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) Board of Education meet
11 on a regular basis; and

12 WHEREAS, The SFUSD accepts and expends millions of San Francisco taxpayer
13 dollars; and,

14 WHEREAS, It is in the public interest that the allocation of tax dollars be monitored by
15 all legally available resources; and,

16 WHEREAS, The SFUSD Board of Education is not required to abide by the San
17 Francisco Sunshine Ordinance provisions; and,

18 WHEREAS, The exclusion of the SFUSD Board of Education from the Sunshine
19 Ordinance provisions has hindered the citizens of San Francisco from knowing precisely how
20 their tax dollars were being allocated and expended by the SFUSD; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges Board of Education
22 to require the San Francisco Unified School District, its officers, employees and Board of
23 Education members to be governed by the provisions of the San Francisco Sunshine
24 Ordinance, Chapter 67 of the San Francisco Administrative Code.




