3 **Resolution authorizing the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice to accept and expend a**
4 **grant in the amount of \$15,075,000 from the Board of Corrections (BOC) for the**
5 **purpose of entirely replacing San Francisco's 52 year old juvenile hall with a modern**
6 **facility that is humane and secure, while increasing its capacity to enhance focus on**
7 **the rehabilitation of the youths detained there.**

9 WHEREAS, on November 12, 1998, California State Board of Corrections issued a
10 Request for Proposal (RFP) for Juvenile and Adult Local Detention Facility Construction
11 grants; and

12 WHEREAS, on March 2, 1999, San Francisco Board of Supervisors passed resolution
13 #134-99 authorizing the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council to apply for up to \$40,000,000 in
14 state (Chapter 499, Statutes of 1998) and Federal (Chapter 282, Statutes of 1997) funds from
15 the BOC; and

16 WHEREAS, on March 17, 1999, San Francisco submitted a proposal responding to
17 that RFP to entirely replace its current Juvenile Hall located at 375 Woodside Avenue; and

18 WHEREAS, in order to meet the RFP's basic requirement of "adding bed space," San
19 Francisco proposed an expansion of 18 beds for a total of 150 beds; and


20 WHEREAS, on October 6, 1999 the BOC awarded San Francisco \$15,075,000
21 towards replacing its juvenile hall facility; and


22 WHEREAS, monies provided by this grant solely funds construction activities, a
23 contract between the state and county will be finalized after the county project bid award,
24 when grant costs can be scheduled and when construction has begun; and

1 WHEREAS, funds received must be expended no later than September 2004, and
2 WHEREAS, due to the requirement that funds be solely used for construction activities,
3 indirect costs are requested to be waived; now, therefore, be it


4 RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the Mayor's

6 Incarceration/Truth in Sentencing grant funds for the purpose of entirely replacing its juvenile




