3 **Resolution commending the upcoming 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the San Francisco Gay**  
4 **Men's Chorus and its continuing contributions to the community and the music world.**

6 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus was founded in 1978, giving their  
7 first performance the night of the assassinations of mayor George Moscone and Supervisor  
8 Harvey Milk; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Chorus' main objectives have been to serve the community and  
10 develop musical excellence; and,

11 WHEREAS, it has fulfilled these goals, first by becoming a positive role model and  
12 fostering a national sense of pride, and by encouraging the formation of new gay and lesbian  
13 choruses; second by performing in sold-out concerts in San Francisco and around the  
14 country; and,

15 WHEREAS, The chorus was honored by the City of San Francisco, presented with a  
16 Key to the City by the then Mayor Dianne Feinstein, the first time that such an honor was  
17 bestowed upon a gay-identified group; and,

18 WHEREAS, In September 2002 the chorus will celebrate its Silver Anniversary Season  
19 commemorating twenty-five years of tireless community service; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
21 commend the San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus on its Silver Anniversary Season; and, be it,

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San  
23 Francisco commend the San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus for their continued invaluable  
24 contributions to the Community and the music world.
